

# How to Start a Business in DC (Checklist)

#### 1. Form a business entity $\Box$

- a. Choose to create either an LLC, corporation, non-profit corporation, limited partnership, or limited liability partnership
- b. Choose a name for your business  $\Box$ 
  - i. Use a business name generator
  - ii. Come up with a unique business name  $\Box$
  - iii. Check your preferred name's availability with the DCRA by doing a business license verification search  $\Box$

#### 2. Get an employer identification number

- a. Apply for an EIN at irs.gov
- b. Record your EIN for future use after receiving your confirmation

## 3. Register your business with the state $\Box$

- a. Use the DC Business Center's wizard  $\Box$
- b. Take note of which licenses and permits you need and where to apply for them  $\Box$

## 4. Obtain applicable state licenses and permits

- a. Use the list generated by the DC Business Center's Wizard  $\Box$
- b. Go to each listed location to apply for and collect the license or permit  $\Box$

## 5. Register for state taxes $\Box$

- a. Use the DC's Office of Tax and Revenue's online service center
  - i. Find requirements for your industry  $\Box$
  - ii. Apply for applicable licenses  $\Box$
  - iii. Pay licensing/permit fees □

## 6. Hire employees and comply with state requirements

- a. Report all new hires to the District of Columbia New Hire Reporting Center  $\Box$
- b. Obtain workers' compensation insurance  $\Box$
- c. Print out and display state-mandated workplace posters  $\Box$
