	Register for your EIN with the IRS.
	1.4. Register your business in Nevada. □
	Use the SilverFlume Business portal and follow the steps to register your business, file
	the correct articles, and pay the registration form.

	2.1. Register for a Nevada state business license. \Box
	Go to the Nevada Secretary of State website and apply online.
	2.2. Find out which industry-specific licenses and permits you need. \Box
	Find all the information and applications you need on the Department of Business and

	If you are in a professional industry, you will need to obtain a license from your industry
	or from the state.
